Student Achievement Committee Meeting
September 11, 2013

Committee Members Present: Committee Chairperson Merrill Adams, Raffaella Fronc, Eileen Buckheit, Victor Friedrich, Nancy Boyle.

Also Present: Director of Curriculum Dr. Linda Berry and Superintendent Dr. Ernest Perlini

The meeting was called to order at 7:57pm by Merrill Adams

- I. Public Comment: There was no public present.
- II. Approval of Agenda: Nancy Boyle moved to approve the agenda. Raffaella seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- III. Test Results: Dr. Berry presented additional data to the general report presented to the full Board the previous month. The new data highlighted areas that became available by studying the results. Dr. Berry explained how the data will be used. The previous report was again provided to the committee. The Power Point presentation highlighted High School SAT, ACT, and AP Results. It also showed 2013 trend comparisons by subject across all grade levels, matched comparisons, and vertical Scale Scores. Dr. Berry emphasized that this is the last year of this generation of testing and new tests based on the Common Core will be used in the future. The committee acknowledged the good growth over the past year.
- IV. Set Priorities for 2013-2014: The committee would like to see proposals at the next meeting that would provide greater emphasis on high achieving students such as AP courses, and enrichment opportunities. The committee would like to review the ADK Survey results from last year. It was suggested we look for ways to reach out to provide more information on the impact of Common Core. The committee would also like to see information on STEM.
- V. Additional 2013-2014 Committee Meetings: The Committee believed the administration had much to do with what has been described for the next meeting. The next meeting will be December 12, 2013 as previously announced,
