REFERENDUM VOTE
Regional School District No. 13

February 8, 2022

A referendum vote of the electors and citizens qualified to vote in town meetings of the Town of Middlefield, Connecticut will be held in the Town of Middlefield at the following place:

Middlefield, Connecticut 06455

and simultaneously in Durham, Connecticut on Tuesday, February 8, 2022, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. pursuant to Section 10-56 of the General Statutes of the State of Connecticut, as amended, upon a resolution adopted by the Regional School District No. 13 Board of Education at a meeting held on January 5, 2021.

The resolution will be placed on the ballot labels as the following question:

“Shall Regional School District No. 13, comprised of the Towns of Durham and Middlefield, appropriate \$7,500,000 for renovations and improvements to John Lyman Elementary School and authorize the issuance of bonds, notes or temporary notes in an amount not to exceed \$7,500,000 to finance the appropriation?

YES NO”

Voters approving the resolution shall vote “Yes” and those opposing the resolution shall vote “No”.

A copy of the full text of the resolution is on file and available for public inspection at the Town Clerk’s Office. Absentee ballots will be available from the Town Clerk’s office.
