An instructional model that focuses on the work of the reader. This model balances direct instruction, guided practice and independent practice, as well as, peer collaboration. Students will have choice selecting books in a variety of genres.

What will my child learn?

- Peer assess with guided constructive feedback
- Provide text evidence to support their thinking
- Determine Author's Purpose
- Set reading goals and use checklists
- To read a variety of genres
- To work collaboratively with peers to deepen and extend their thinking

CURRICULUM, INSTRUCTION & ASSESSMENT Writers' Workshop



Writers' Workshop is an instructional model that fosters students' independence through an authentic writing process. Students use strategies taught in the mini lesson along with a mentor text to craft their writing. Students draft, revise and edit their writing by conferring with their teacher and peers. The writing process is celebrated at the end of each unit in a variety of ways.

What will my child learn?

- The Writing Process: Plan, Draft, Revise, Edit, Publish
- Narrative Writing
- Informational and Research Writing
- Argument Writing
- To use checklists and set writing goals
- To write for a specific purpose and audience
