#### Students will learn:

writing embedded grammar study analytical writing model

Write arguments to support claims in an analysis of substantive topics or texts, using valid reasoning and relevant and sufficient evidence [CCSS W 9-12.1]

narrative writing model

Write narratives to develop real or imagined experiences or events using effective technique, well-chosen details, and well-structured event sequences [CCSS W 9-12.3]
Informative writing model

Write informative/explanatory texts to examine and convey complex ideas, concepts, and information clearly and accurately through the effective selection, organization, and analysis of content [CCSS W 9-12.2]
